Insurance	<ul> <li>Each Exchange Student must keep a valid health insurance throughout their stay in Malaysia.</li> <li>Exchange Students staying in Malaysia for more than six (6) months will be required to purchase a Malaysia insurance upon their arrival.</li> <li>Student Exchange staying in Malaysia less than 6 months are also encourage to purchase a Malaysia Insurance</li> <li>Insurance fee: approximately RM300 per semester</li> </ul>	
Visa	<ul> <li>All international students are required to apply for student pass and visa for the purpose of their stay in Malaysia.</li> <li>USM will help students to apply for the student pass and visa after their arrival; students are to enter Malaysia as tourists.</li> <li>Student Visa fee: RM 150.</li> </ul>
